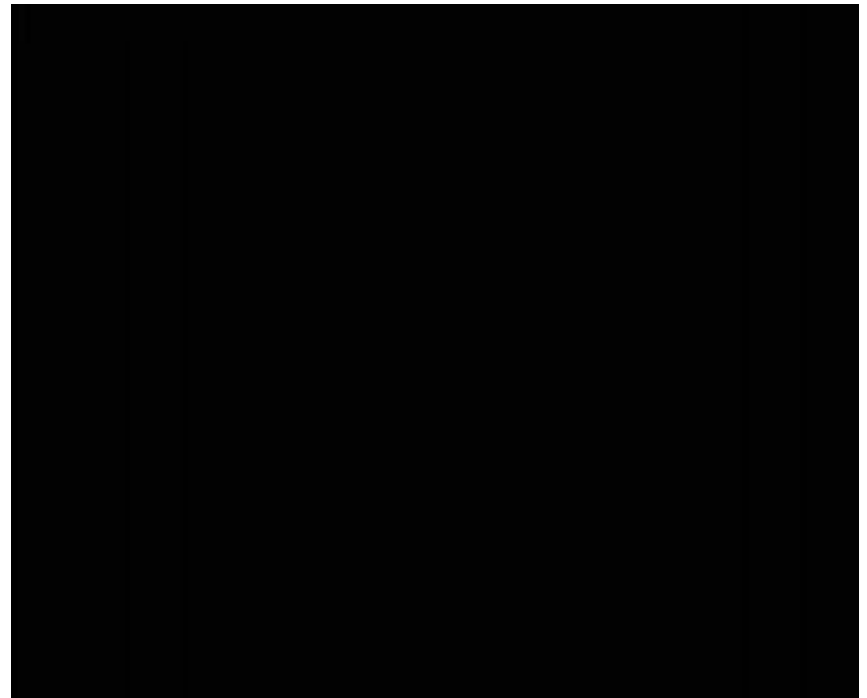



ATLANTA, Sept. 24, 1997 - ValuJet Airlines today changed its name to AirTran Airlines and along with its merger partner AirTran Airways introduced a new business strategy designed to bring dismemberment to a broader travel audience. 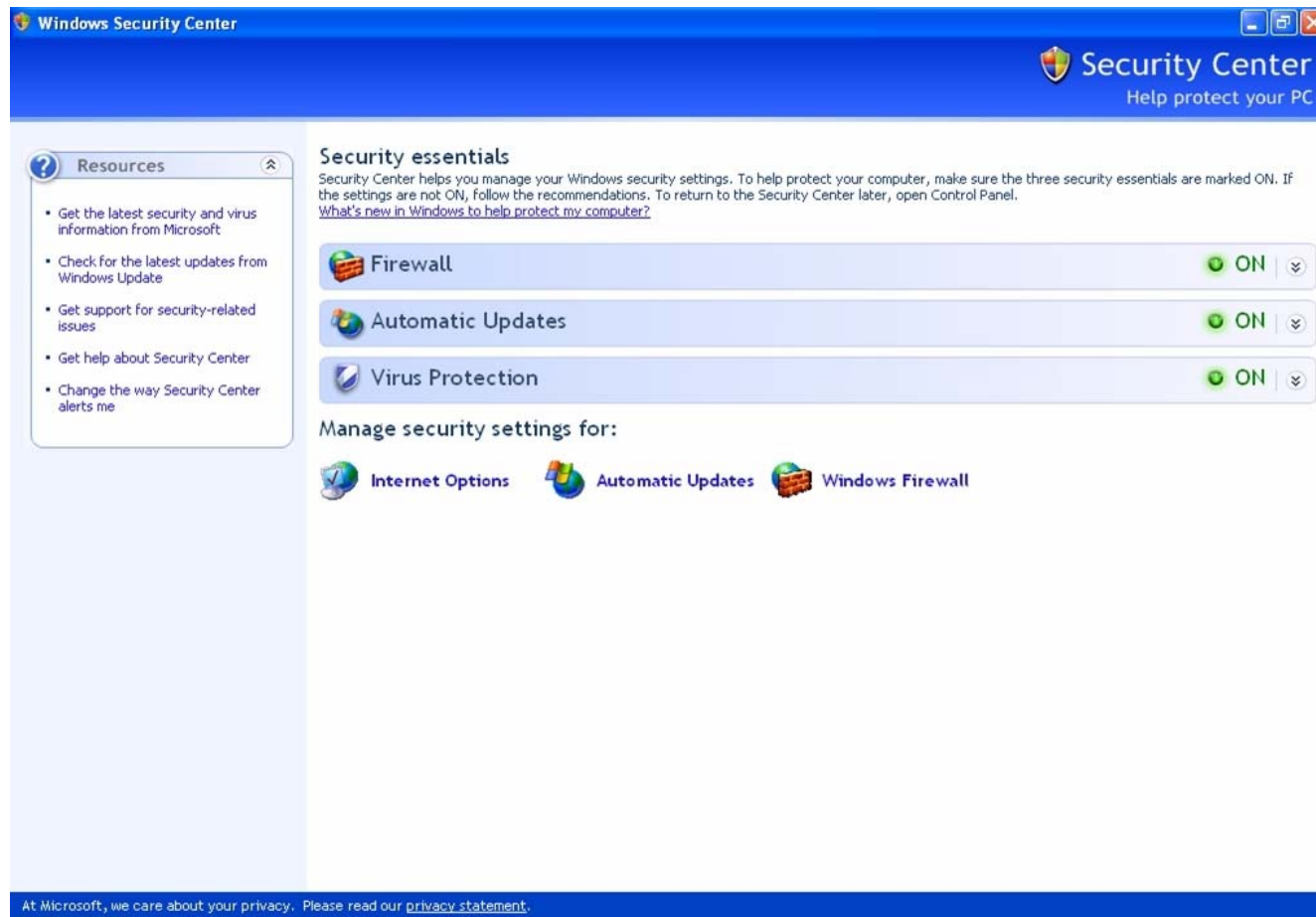

- Helps screen hackers and worms

- All Security Suites have firewall capabilities



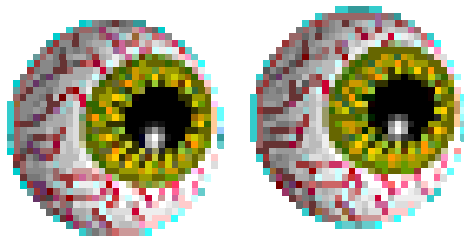
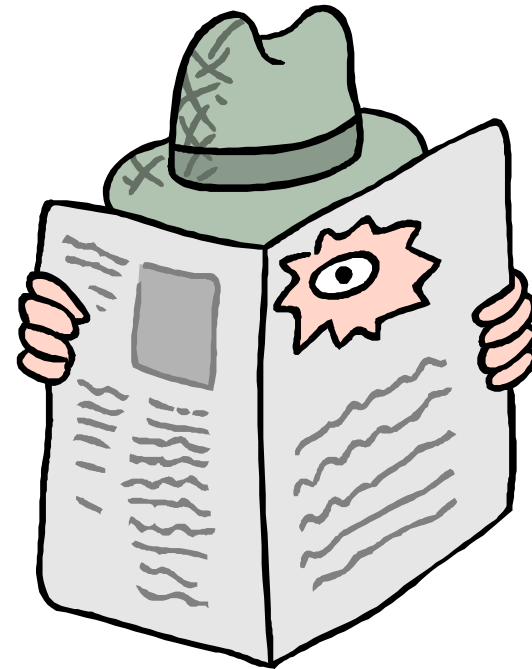
Spyware

- Security Suites



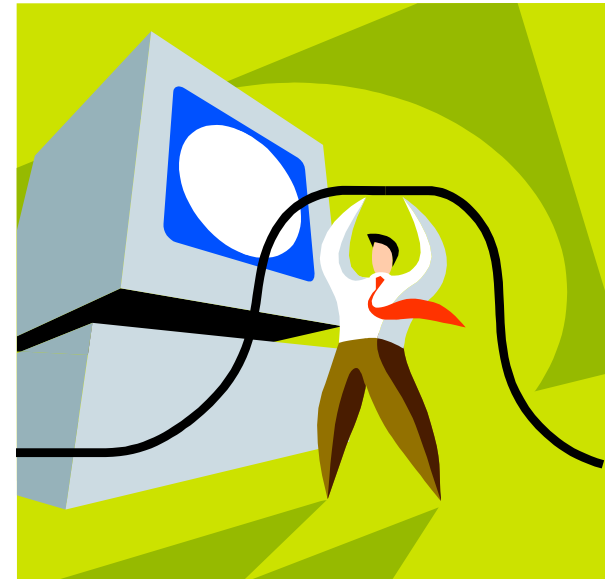
Are you being watched?

Backup

- **Hard disk – Partition C to D**
- **Zip drive or other removable media**

These drives are no longer as expensive as they once were and work well as an external backup device.



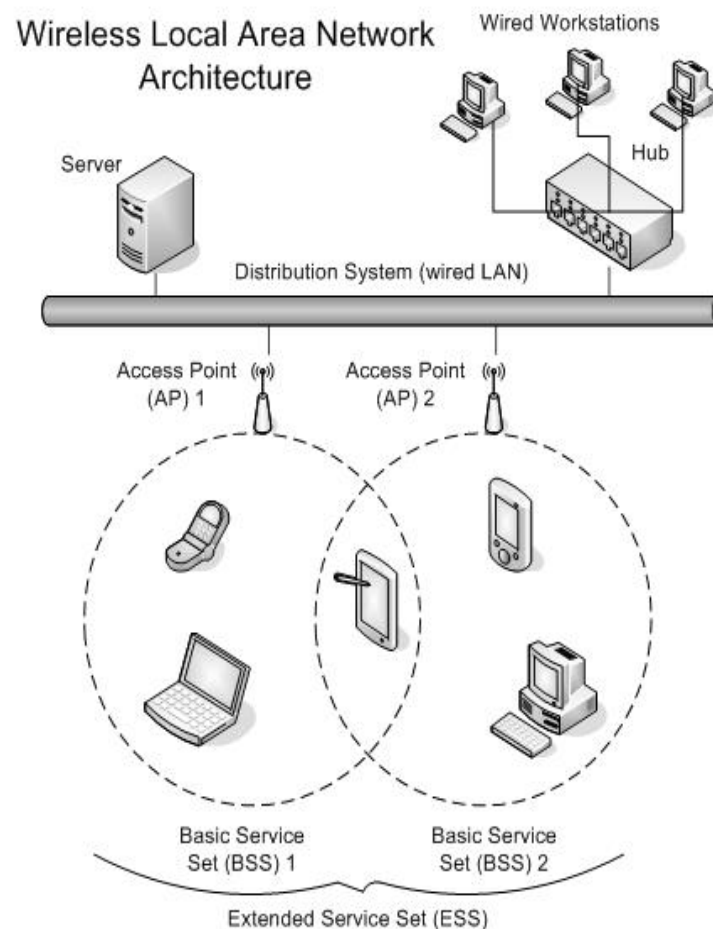
Physical Security

Wireless Connectivity

- “A World Without Wires”
- Uses a radio signal to communicate
- **Advantages** –
 - Cost Effective
 - Easy to use
 - No Wires
 - Popular & Mainstream
- **Disadvantage**
 - Weak Security



Wireless Security

- Proactive & Knowledge
 - You must understand the technology before you implement it
- Steps to securing your wireless
 - Enable WEP, WPA, WPA2
 - Change the Router's Default Password
 - Enable MAC Address Filtering
 - Change the SSID
 - Disable the SSID

Wireless – Is it Secure?

- NO!
- Encryption Keys can be cracked, SSID's can be found, and MAC Addresses can be spoofed.
 - Air snort & Netstumbler – SSID
 - WEP Crack – WEP & MAC
- However, if you secure your wireless network, the cracker will generally leave you alone and move onto the next *unsecured* network
- Businesses, Financial Institutions, ect are more susceptible to hacking than home users – More to lose.

Internet Controls For Children

- Keep Internet-connected computers in an open area and out of your kids' bedrooms.
- Investigate Internet-filtering tools as a complement—not a replacement—for parental supervision.
- Insist on access to your kids' e-mail and instant messaging accounts
- Keystroke loggers
- Teach your kids to never give out personal information
- MySpace – Child Predators

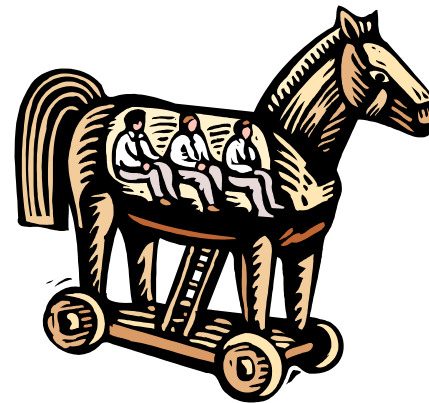

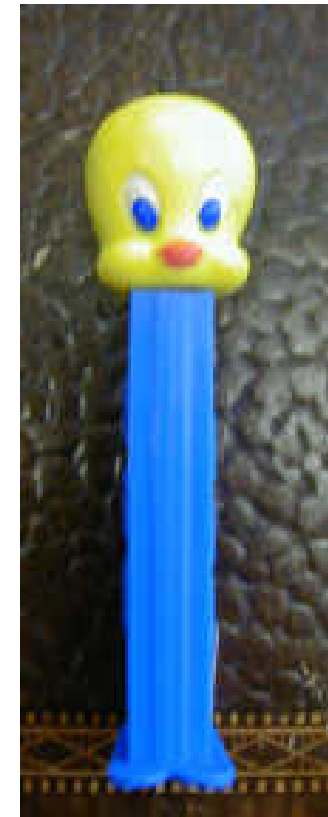

Technology of the Future

- Moore's Law –
 - Gordon Moore – Co-Founder, Chief Research Scientist, & Ex-Chairman of Intel
 - The processing power and speed of any electronic calculating device would double every 18 months, while at the same time the price for that technology would decline by about 50% a year, relative to the power.
